

Criteria for Membership in Jericho High School Honor Societies

Jericho Chapter National Honor Society

To be eligible for NHS a student must have completed 10th grade with a 3.6 unweighted GPA.

The following criteria applies to candidates and members:

- Attend at least 8 meetings by Mid- March.
- Complete 10 hours of “in-school” service (maximum of 5 hours in one activity).
- Complete 15 hours of “out of school” service or volunteer work. These hours must be completed in the same location. Prior approval of site required.
- Actively participate in at least 2 National Honor Society activities or fundraisers.
- Candidate dues \$10; Members dues \$5.
- Signed parent /candidate participation form.
- Maintain 3.6 unweighted GPA

Members who do not fulfill all requirements will not be permitted to wear the NHS cords at commencement.

- Must have faculty recommendation.

World Languages National Honor Societies

In order to be eligible for induction and membership in the French, Italian, Latin, Spanish Honor Societies and/or Chinese, a student must meet the following requirements:

- Maintain an A- average in the specific language:
This includes:
 - all years of language study in high school,
 - the first semester of the current school year,
 - the average from grade 8 (as it is a HS credit bearing course),
 - Latin/Chinese requirement is a minimum of 3 semesters.
- Maintain a B- average overall in high school.
- Be enrolled in grade 10, 11 or 12.
- Be currently enrolled in a world language.
- Attend the required number of meetings and participate in the required activities as outlined by the chapter advisor.

Although academic averages are consistent across the societies, specific service responsibilities will vary. Students must determine their own eligibility, speak with the chapter advisor, and attend meetings by October 1 of the intended year of induction.
