ASCENT SCHOOL FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH AUTISM

Ascent is a private, non-profit school for children diagnosed with autism and atypical pervasive developmental disorders. It provides a full day, 12-month academic and behavioral treatment program to children ranging from ages 3 to 21. Ascent primarily serves children who have experienced failure in the Nassau & Suffolk public schools, who require a high degree of individualized attention and intervention. The individualized attention at Ascent helps each child reach specific goals. For some Ascent students that means job training or returning to mainstream school environments, for others it means speaking their first words, eating on their own, and acquiring bathroom independence. These basic life skills can help a child remain in his/her own environment.

WHAT IS AUTISM?

- Autism is defined as a complex developmental disability that typically appears during the first three years of life. The result of this neurological disorder, which affects the functioning of the brain, is characterized by the absence of the innate ability to learn and communicate.
- Autism is more prevalent than childhood cancer, down syndrome, and cystic fibrosis.
- Autism receives less than 5% of the funding of other less common disorders.
- 1 in 166 children are diagnosed with autism.
- Boys are 4 times more likely than girls to be diagnosed with autism.
- **Currently, there is no medical detection or cure for autism.**
