- *The Board of Education unanimously adopted the 2018-2019 Budget of \$122,653,735. This will be on the ballot for the May 15 Budget Vote.
- *Also, the board adopted proposition #2, which will be on the ballot on May 15. This proposition authorizes the board to spend \$16.2 million from the already existing Capital Reserves and fund balance to implement the third phase of projects from the Capital Facilities Plan, which is detailed in the Budget Workshops available here: https://bit.ly/2FUxkma
