

2022-2023 Academic Year WORLD LANGUAGES HONOR SOCIETIES

[Requirements effective August 21, 2020]

What are the requirements for students to enter each of the honor societies?

1. Maintain an **A-** average in the specific language, including
 - all years of high school study in that language (at least two years completed in 9th and 10th grade)
 - the first semester of the current school year
 - the course grade from grade 8 (as it is a high school credit-bearing course)
2. Maintain a **B+** average overall in high school, including all high school credit-bearing courses.
3. Enrolled in grade 11 or 12.
4. Enrolled in the language.
5. Attend the required number of meetings and participate in the required activities (at least 80%) as outlined by the chapter advisor. It is your responsibility to sign in at meetings.

Are the requirements available to students and/or parents?

We will share these requirements so that they can be published on our webpage. Students must have met the 80% participation/attendance requirement at the events.

Do students receive invitations based upon the requirements, or do they have to do anything on their own to be considered?

All students are made aware of the grade requirements and attendance requirements (e.g., in class, or at an assembly). Requirements of active membership are given to 10th and 11th graders. Those 11th and 12th graders who think they may be eligible can apply. Advisors and Guidance also have the application. The verification process will take place thereafter to determine inductee status.

The above requirements have been in effect for all students who began 10th grade in 2020-2021, or later.
